### Washtenaw County Senior Millage — Trip Eligibility

Trips are supported in part by the Washtenaw County Senior Millage. Seats are reserved for members age 60+ and a resident of Washtenaw County.

All remaining seats are available at full non-subsidized cost to MSCC members ages 55–59 and then to non-Washtenaw County residents.
